Bylaw #414/14

A bylaw to recover Protective Services costs

The Council of the Town of Stoughton, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions under the Traffic Bylaw:

- (1) '*Municipality*' means the Town of Stoughton.
- (2) '*Council*' shall mean the council of the municipality; and
- (3) '*Administrator*' shall mean the administrator of the municipality.
- (4) '*Fire Department*' shall mean the Stoughton & District Volunteer Fire Department.

2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services supplied by the Fire Department shall be charged directly on the person(s) who receive the service, providing such costs are not covered by the owner(s) insurance policy, in accordance with in Schedule 'A' as attached.

3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid

- (1) at the end of the calendar year.
- (2) 90 days after the person has been invoiced for said services
- (3) at the end of the calendar year or 90 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
