

BYLAW #372/09

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STOUGHTON OF THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP UPON GRADUATION FROM STOUGHTON CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL.

Whereas the Council of the Town of Stoughton deems it desirable to award a Scholarship to a graduating member of the Grade Twelve class of Stoughton Central High School and pursuing post-secondary education.

The Council of the Town of Stoughton, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. A Selection Committee comprised of three members including: a Local School Counsel, a town Councillor and a Stoughton Central High School representative such as the Principal or Vice-Principal.
2. The Stoughton Town Council will appoint a member to the selection committee in January of each year and make request of the Principal of the Stoughton High School to name a member by May 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.
3. The Selection Committee shall meet at the beginning of June each year at the call of the Councillor to consider applications for the Town of Stoughton Scholarship. The committee shall advise Council of recommendations by the second meeting in June. Final approval of the recipient remains with the Council for the Town of Stoughton.
4. The criteria to be considered for the scholarship is as follows:
  - a) Academic minimum of 80% average on post-secondary entrance calculation.  
English 30A  
English 30B  
Social Studies 30  
A Science (General Math)  
One of Math 30 Level  
Two Other Best Marks  
*Maximum Score 100*
  - b) Contributions to extracurricular activities:  
-S.R.C., Year Book etc. (10 points per activity)  
*Maximum Score 50*
  - c) Athletic Contribution:  
-School or Community Athletic Team (10 points per activity)  
*Maximum Score 50*
  - d) Contributions to Community:  
-Volunteer Activities (50 point per activity)  
*Maximum Score 200*  
*Total Maximum Score 400*
5. A letter from each volunteer agency is required when submitting an application.
6. Any volunteer hours may be worked throughout the high school years (Grades 10 to 12).
7. The recipient must provide the Council with proof of enrollment in a post secondary educational establishment in the fall prior to receiving one half of the total scholarship. The remainder of the scholarship is to be paid after proof of registration for the second semester.
8. Payment of the scholarship may be delayed by one year if requested in writing by the recipient.
9. The full amount of the Stoughton Scholarship has been set at \$1,000.00 (One Thousand).
10. Bylaw # 260/96 is hereby repealed.
