

BYLAW #427/15

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STOUGHTON TO ESTABLISH THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR DEPOSITS ON ALL WATER ACCOUNTS.

The Council of the Town of Stoughton, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. All persons desiring to be supplied with water from the Municipality's water supply system shall make application to the officials of the Municipality. Each application shall be accompanied with a payment of a fee or meter deposit as follows:


5/8"	meter	\$100.00
3/4"	meter	\$125.00
1"	meter	\$150.00
1-1/4"	meter	\$200.00
1-1/2"	meter	\$250.00
2"	meter	\$375.00

Plus a \$25.00 installation charge on all new meters regardless of size.

2. Where an account has been created for a tenant other than the property owner, both the property owner and tenant are required to pay a deposit against the account.
3. At the time of closing an account, the deposit will be applied against the final balance owing and in such cases where the deposit is greater than the amount owing a cheque will be issued to the account holder for the remainder of the deposit.
