Dutch Elm Disease Control & Prevention

Dutch Elm Disease has been identified in Stoughton and Council has commissioned



to do a full assessment of the Elm trees in town. They will not only identify trees for removal, but also trees that can be treated and saved.

Surveying will take place the week of August 28

All public & private properties will be inspected to identify, test and tag diseased trees. Please do not remove or destroy any markings left behind. Firewood piles will also be inspected.

Surveyors will carry a Dutch Elm Disease Technician ID badge, and attempt to inform the homeowner of their presence.

Success of eradicating Dutch Elm Disease depends on the removal or treatment of all infected trees so please allow surveyors access.

Once a report is received and we know the extent of the spread of disease, Council will review options on the best way in which to proceed.
