PURPOSE

The Town of Stoughton recognizes that the laterals of the duplexes owned by Stoughton Housing Authority along Jones Avenue are not sloped correctly into the sewer mains and as such back-ups may occur.

DEFINITION

'Properties' means only the duplexes owned by the Stoughton Housing Authority known as 102, 104, 106 & 108 E Jones Avenue.

'Tenant' means any person occupying the property under agreement with Stoughton Housing Authority.

POLICY STATEMENT

Stoughton Housing Authority will not be charged for sewer snake jobs at the properties so long as the blockage is not directly caused by the tenant.

If Public Works determines that the tenant caused the blockage by allowing an item(s) to go through the sewer line that is not regularly allowed then Stoughton Housing Authority shall be liable for the cost of the sewer snake at regular rates.
