In addition to this support, the Town was also provided with a further \$53,860 contribution through the Western Economic Diversification Canada under the Canada Community Revitalization Fund. 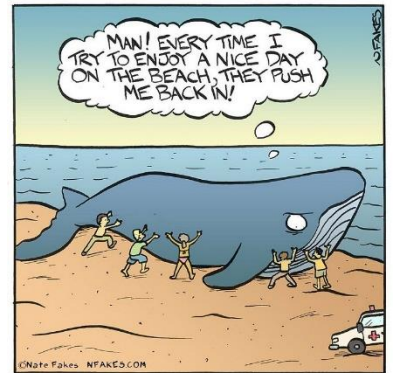
