

TOWN OF STOUGHTON

BYLAW #478/24

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No.#467/22 known as the Fire Prevention Bylaw.

The Council of the Town of Stoughton, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts Bylaw No.#478/24 as follows:

1. Section 2a. of Bylaw #467/22, known as the Fire Prevention Bylaw be changed to read as follows:

“ Materials which may be burned shall consist only of charcoal or cut, seasoned wood or manufactured fire logs. The burning of the following material is prohibited;

- ***Household garbage***
- ***Garden refuse***
- ***Leaves or grass***
- ***Manure***
- ***Livestock or animal carcasses***
- ***Any material classified as dangerous good and any material which, when burned, will generate black smoke or an offensive odor including insulation from electrical wiring or equipment, asphalt, roofing materials, hydrocarbons, plastic, rubber materials creosote wood or any similar material”***

2. That the following be added to Section 2(b) as subsection (iv):

“If smoke from a fire pit or outdoor fireplace causes an unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another’s persons property, the fire shall be extinguished immediately.”

3. That this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date it is adopted by Council.
