August 31 and begins again
April 1.

to the Stoughton Transfer
Station. **Tell the attendant
that you have elm wood**, and
they will direct you where to
leave it. Do not keep elm wood
for firewood. Proper disposal
helps prevent the spread of
Dutch elm disease.

- Clear gutters and downspouts.** Direct water away from your foundation.
- Keep yard drains and drainage paths clear.**

Watch the forecast and check your basement during heavy rain.
